Freshman

Application and Portfolio Deadline: February 1st, 2013. However, Michigan uses a rolling admission process so more seats are available early in the year. We highly recommend students attempt to meet the early action deadline of November 1, 2012. Admission is limited to Fall term only.

 - (non-native English speakers only)
- Two letters of recommendation
 - High school counselor
 - Academic core teacher
