As a continuation of A312, this course, A322, will build on your capacity to translate architectural ideas into form and space, and now add in how buildings are sited into existing circumstances - both conceptually in their ideological framing and literally in how buildings are situated in the landscape and contend with the space around the building itself. This studio focuses on the social and physical contexts in which we build, how people perceive the occupied environment, how buildings fit contextually into existing circumstances, and how outdoor spaces relate to built forms. The work to be undertaken includes both analysis of existing examples and synthesis incorporating the many dimensions of architectural environments in design. The course concludes with a design of a free-standing building of modest scale and complexity.
